Edgefield County is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Litter Control/Code Enforcement Officer for the Building and Planning Department. Job requirements include answering complaints related to illegal dumping of trash, tires, household items, etc.; performs and assists in the collection of litter from roadways and public property; is responsible for enforcing County Ordinances and State laws in all matters of Code enforcement; this includes property nuisance, litter, zoning, discrepancies, and mobile home registration. The ability to communicate courteously and effectively are essential job skills. Requires a Class 3 certification from the SC Criminal Justice Academy; legal work a plus, 2 to 3 years in law enforcement or as a constable, or an equivalent combination of education, training, Licenses, Certificates, Registrations, and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities. Firearms handling; ability to remain calm under a variety of circumstances. Must possess a valid state driver's license. Salary will depend on qualifications and experience. Edgefield County conducts pre-employment testing for the use of illegal substances, as well as criminal and DMV background checks.
