In the identified area, the current year population is 176,364. In 2010, the Census count in the area was 166,180. The rate of change since 2010 was 0.72% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 183,623 representing a change of 0.81% annually from 2018 to 2023. Currently, the population is 47.7% male and 52.3% female.

Currently, 49.8% of the 81,971 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 40.8%, renter occupied; and 9.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 77,482 housing units in the area - 52.1% owner occupied, 38.2% renter occupied, and 9.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.53%. Median home value in the area is \$158,470, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.42% annually to \$178,572.
