

2021 EDGEFIELD COUNTY PROPERTY TAX RATE NOTICE

As Treasurer for Edgefield County, I will officially open the tax books for the collection of 2021 property taxes on Monday, **October 4, 2021**.

Tax bills are in the name of the owner on record as of December 31, 2020

If ownership has since changed and a tax bill is not received, it is the responsibility of the new owner to request one. **Failure to receive a tax bill because of an incorrect address or change in ownership will not result in the waiver of incurred penalties**. Omitted payments are the sole responsibility of the taxpayer.

The tax bill should be presented when making the payment.

If an escrow account is involved and the mortgage company requests the tax bill for payment, the tax information will be supplied to the mortgage company and a tax statement mailed to the property owner. It is the property owner's responsibility to see that the tax bill is paid by the mortgage company and/or the property owner.

All tax payments are due and payable without penalty by close of business on January 18, 2022. Appropriate penalties as shown on the tax bill will be

assessed and collected as a part of the total tax bill after January 18, 2022. No partial payments will be accepted. Tax payments bearing a United States postal stamped date of January 18, 2022, will be accepted without penalty.

When the end of the tax period falls on Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the tax period is extended to the next business day. A legal holiday is any day the Courthouse or the offices of the United States Postal Service are closed.
