Old Business

1. Consideration of approval of the second reading of ordinance 21-23-785, authorizing the enlargement of the joint county industrial park dated February 11, 2019, between Saluda County, South Carolina, and Edgefield County, South Caroling, so as to enlarge the park to include the certain property of [Project Eagle]; and other matters related thereto.

Chairman Campbell: I will ask Administrator Caddell to give us a quick explanation for this item.

Administrator Caddell: I have little to add except to point out to the public that this is not a real physical Industrial Park. This is a paperwork process or essentially a tax treatment for the benefit of the company that is located in our County and we are doing this in partnership with Saluda County.

Chairman Campbell: The third reading would be in our December meeting and a public hearing in which the Project Eagle would be named.

Administrator Caddell: That is correct, and we will also consider a third reading of the fee-in-lieu taxes for this same agreement.

Chairman Campbell: Questions or comments from the Council. Hearing none. Councilman Moody made the motion, and Councilman Talbert seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
